



Spur Volunteer Fire Department Receives \$10,000 from South Plains Electric Cooperative and CoBank

LUBBOCK, TX (X) – Spur Volunteer Fire Department received a \$10,000 donation from South Plains Electric Cooperative and CoBank to help them build a new fire station. This donation comes as the old building at the new location of the fire house is being demolished. The check presentation will be on Thursday, June 23, at 2 p.m. at the future fire station site at 3rd St. and Burlington Ave.

The Spur Volunteer Fire Department was in major need of a new fire station. Their building was built in the early 1900s and it was to the point of being unrepairable; they needed a brand-new building. Not only will it help the fire department, but it will also help Spur's economic development. Local individuals have already partnered to build the VFD a new building, and South Plains Electric and CoBank are honored to help.
