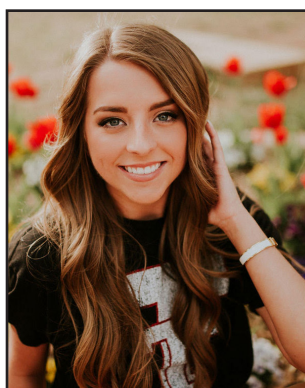

"My career goals are to earn an interior design degree and minor in architecture and business. After college, I would love to help build and design homes."

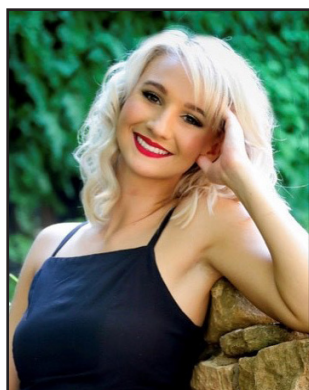

"My career goals are to become a basketball coach to help the youth improve their weaknesses and highlight their strengths."

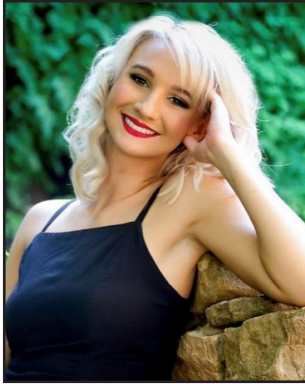
Operation Round Up Employee Fund
